Inhalation

pumps or vacuum equipment. Dike and recover contaminated water for appropriate disposal. Collect using shovel/scoop or approved HEPA vacuum and place in a suitable container for disposal. Get expert advice before treating the spilled product with other chemicals to make it less hazardous. Store recovered product in suitable containers that are: contact emergency services and manufacturer/supplier for advice.

SECTION 7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Precautions for Safe Handling

Obtain special instructions before use. Avoid breathing in this product. Prevent skin contact. Avoid repeated or prolonged skin contact. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not swallow. Only use where there is adequate ventilation. Avoid generating vapours or mists. Avoid release to the environment. Immediately report leaks, spills or failures of the safety equipment (e.g. ventilation system). Eliminate heat and ignition sources such as sparks, open flames, hot surfaces and static discharge.
